BOARD OF APPEALS

MINUTES OF THE MEETING July 1, 2020 - 7:30 A.M. VIA CONFERENCE CALL DUE TO COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

Members Present: Earl Williams, Chairperson, Neil Dick, Patricia Barz, Nancy Moore, and Joseph MacDonald. Also Present: William M. Ondrey Gruber, Director of Law, Lisa Gold-Scott, Assistant Director of Law, John Becker, Assistant Director of Public Works, and Lori Pickens and Charles Orłowski of the Public Works Department for the City, and Appellant Ilgaz Arikan.

1. Chairperson Earl Williams called the meeting to order and made a preliminary announcement about the procedure for the virtual hearing. Mr. Gruber called the roll of members present.
2. Ms. Barz moved to approve the Minutes of June 3, 2020. Mr. Dick seconded the motion. The motion was approved 5-0.
3. Mr. Gruber reviewed the agenda.
5. Chairperson Williams explained the procedure for the hearings.
6. The Board called and heard the following appeals:
 - a. Appeal of Ilgaz Arikan, Case No. BA-20-08-NAPW, 22600 Shaker Boulevard, Notice of Public Nuisance – Tree. Mr. Arikan testified in his own behalf. Charles Orłowski, Lori Pickens and John Becker testified on behalf of the City
 6. Appeal of Deona Davis, Case No. BA-20-09-NAPW, 3417 Westbury Road, Notice of Public Nuisance – Grass. No one appeared for Appellant. Lori Pickens and John Becker testified on behalf of the City.
7. Mr. Dick. moved that the Board go into executive session to discuss the appeals. Mrs. Moore seconded the Motion. The Board voted 5-0 in a roll call vote to go into executive session to discuss the appeal.
8. The Board reached the following decisions in the appeals:
 - a. Appeal of Ilgaz Arikan, 22600 Shaker Boulevard: It was moved by Mrs. Moore to deny the appeal. The Motion was seconded by Mr. Williams. The Board voted 5-0 to approve the Motion.
 - b. Appeal of Deona Davis, 3417 Westbury Road:
 - (i) It was moved by Mr. Dick to deny the Appellant's request for a continuance. The Motion was seconded by Ms. Barz. The Board voted 5-0 to approve the Motion.

(ii) It was moved by Mrs. Moore to deny the appeal. The Motion was seconded by Ms. Barz. The Motion was approved by the Board 5-0.
