

Green Gator Bags help you help your new tree lawn tree survive—here's how!

Young trees grow best, and are more likely to survive with slow deep watering once a week, allowing the soil to dry between watering. A 2-inch diameter tree needs 15 gallons of water per week.

In spring, newly planted tree lawn trees have green “**Gator Bags**” around them, and these bags remain in place until fall. Each bag has a hole between 2 black straps at the top. Shaker Heights residents are requested to fill each bag once a week, rain or shine. After the bag is one-fourth full, gently lift up on the black straps, then resume watering.
